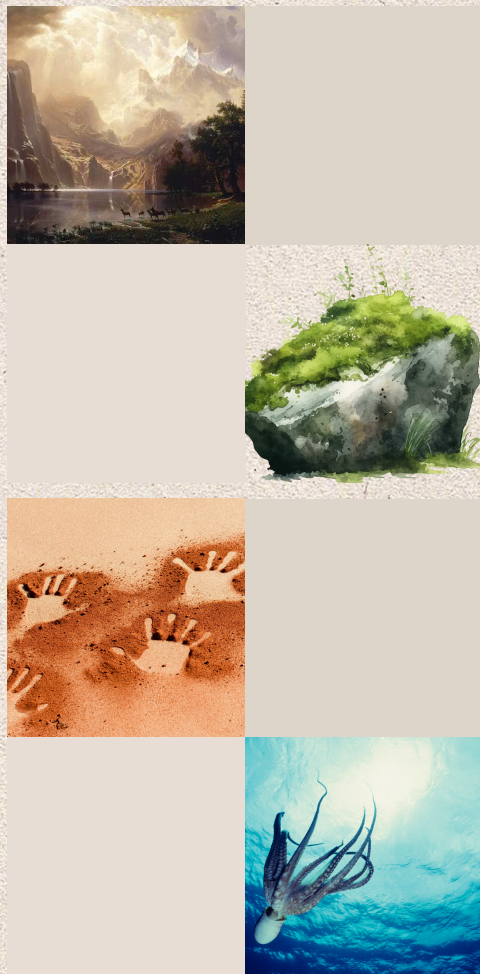

This workshop focuses on the important roles of the arts in biocultural conservation, restoration, and communication, and looks to reflect on the relationship between the arts and the environment in the context of new socio-environmental crises, such as climate change, mass extinctions, and shifts in the experience of nature. Participants will share their experiences and ideas about practicing biocultural conservation and restoration through art projects or related experiences, explore mechanisms of taking liberties of arts for biocultural communication, and participate in panel discussions. The workshop will delve into the domains of environmental education and biocultural conservation through the arts such as story-telling, painting, gardening, digital photography, performance, and eco-exhibitions across the globe, analyzing their mechanisms and feedbacks, as well as drawing on them for future environmental pedagogy and art education. This will be an ideal learning experience for students from environmental subjects, art education, philosophy, etc., and will be a great opportunity for all participants to review and exchange ideas.
